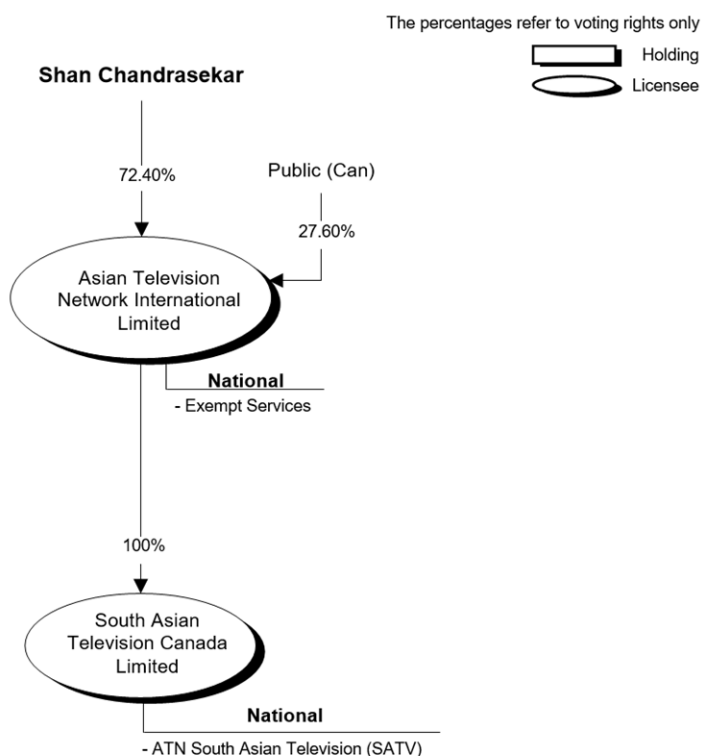

CRTC 2019-79 – revoked the licence of the national ethnic specialty Category B service ATN SONY (formerly South Asian Television Canada Channel 2), in order to continue its operation as an exempt undertaking.
