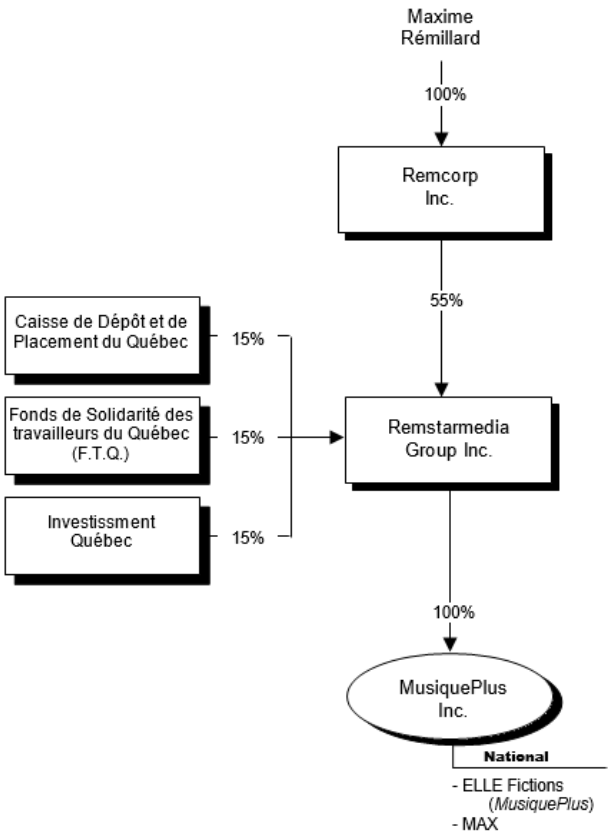


Remstar TV & Discretionary Services

UPDATE

Administrative Approval – 2014-05-26 – approved a corporate reorganisation resulting in a change in the effective control of V Interactions inc. and 7340362 Canada Inc. from a joint control by Julien and Maxime Rémillard to a legal control by Maxime Rémillard.

Update – 2014-06-23 – 3947424 Canada Inc. changed its name to Groupe V Média inc. on 26 March 2010.

Amalgamation – 2014-07-01 – of Madman Investments Inc. and Madman-Inferno Holdings Inc. and to continue as Madman-Inferno Holdings Inc.

CRTC 2014-465 – approved a change in the ownership and effective control of MusiquePlus Inc., licensee of MusiquePlus and MusiMax, from the trustee Mr. Pierre Boivin to Mr. Maxime Rémillard, subject to certain modifications and conditions.

Update – 2015-05-12 – 7340362 Canada Inc. did not implement V MAX within the prescribed timeframe of 13 May 2015.

Update – 2015-06-02 – 7340362 Canada Inc. did not implement Pure TV within the prescribed timeframe of 2 February 2015.

Update – 2015-06-17 – 7340362 Canada Inc. did not implement Bella TV within the prescribed timeframe of 1 June 2015.

Service name change – 2016-10-24 – MusiMax now MAX.

Amalgamation – 2017-01-01 – of Madman-Inferno Holdings Inc., Remstar Group Inc. and Remstar Broadcasting Inc. and to continue as Remstar Group Inc.

Update – 2017-10-17 – of various types of services.

CRTC 2020-115 – approved a change in ownership of MusiquePlus Inc. through the transfer of all of the shares, currently held by Groupe V Média inc., to MusiquePlus (OBCI) (Newco).

CRTC 2020-116 & CRTC 2020-154 – amalgamation of Groupe V Média inc. with its subsidiary V Interactions inc. to form a corporation, the name of which is to be determined (VFusion). After the amalgamation, all of the issued and outstanding shares of VFusion will be transferred from Remstar and other shareholders to Bell Canada. Afterwards, Bell Canada will transfer all of the shares of VFusion to Bell Media Inc.

NOTE: The ownership changes were reflected.

Update – 2020-04-20 – incorporation on 20 March 2020 of Remstarmedia Group Inc. and name change on 24 October 2019 of Remstar Group Inc. to Remcorp Inc.

Update – 2020-08-14 – the ownership of Groupe V Média Inc. was transferred to Bell Media Inc. (see Decisions CRTC 2020-116 & CRTC 2020-154).
