APTN met regularly with close to 100 Indigenous producers who debuted a total of 188 titles on the network during the 2019-2020 broadcast year. Meeting frequency ranged from multiple times per week – especially during development – to semi-weekly or less, as productions entered their rhythm. Our Manager of Programming – West, who oversees Moosemeat and Marmelade, reports its producer consults her weekly even though the program is in its 5th season. These are just meetings involving programs under consideration or that have been greenlit. We regularly receive referrals from Indigenous producers we’ve previously worked with and also welcome producer cold calls. APTN is aware of the need to further bolster the Indigenous production ecosystem and constantly keeps its eyes open for new talent. Diamonds in the rough are often discovered at film festivals. In B.C. alone, we participate in the Whistler Film Festival, the Victoria Film Festival, the Vancouver Film Festival, the Indigenous Film Festival and the Talking Stick Film Festival, to name a few. Across the network, it’s estimated we held more than 2,500 meetings with Indigenous producers throughout the year.
